



Recycling ABC's.... Making your time count!



The following may be mixed with other products in the recycle container

Plastics - Plastic number should be listed on the bottom or side of the container. Rinse all plastic & remove lids, caps, rings & labels

- #1 Plastics: (Clear and green) - Soda, water, and flavored beverage bottles
- #2 Plastics: (Colored) - Milk & Juice jugs, Detergent & fabric softener containers
- #3 Plastics: PVC (Narrow neck only) - Health & beauty aid products, households cleaner
- #4 Plastics: PVC - Margarine tubs, frozen desert cups, 6 & 12 pack rings
- #5 Plastics: PVC - Yogurt cups, narrow neck syrup & ketchup bottles
- #7 Plastics: Plastic resin - Plastic buckets such as kitty litter containers (5 gal. maximum size) Plastic Milk & Juice cartons

Other

The following is NOT to be mixed with other products to avoid contamination

Paper Products

- Newspaper, including inserts (Remove plastic sleeves)
- Cardboard (No pizza boxes or waxed cardboard)
- Chipboard (Cereal, cake / food mix boxes, gift boxes etc.)
- Carrier stock (Soda & beer can cases) Kraft (Brown paper) bags
- Magazines, catalogs, telephone books
- Office, computer, notebook & gift wrap (No metal clips, spirals, binders)
- Junk mail & envelopes (No plastic cards, stick on labels, or unused stamps)
- Paper back books (No hard cover books)



Tin/Steel/Aluminum Cans

- Any beverage cans made from aluminum
- Vegetable & soup cans
- Aluminum trays & foil (all must be cleaned)
- Steel cans & tins



Brown, Clear & Green Glass Jars / Bottles

- No window glass, mirrors, drinking glasses & kitchen cooking glass (such as Pyrex)

Notes:

- All containers to be emptied and rinsed clean
- No motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemical containers
- Plastic bags should be returned to grocery or department stores
- No plastic film (no plastic sheets, tarps, or wraps)
- No expanded foam or clear polystyrene (per joint advisory from the Ill Recycling Assoc.)

*** If you are unsure whether a material is recyclable, please do not place it in the Recycle Container ***
